## **RENEWABLE ENERGY – Announces US\$10 Million Acquisition for Intellectual Property License with ENTECH for USA**

Clarington Ontario - Canadian energy developer Renewable Energy Management Inc. (REM) announced today that it acquired the ENTECH™ intellectual properties license for the United States.

REM's Managing Director, Stan Kinsman indicated, "We have been working with Entech for several years in the US with the County of Los Angeles Solid Waste Management department as well as in other locations in the US – the acquisition was a natural progression for the growth of our Company and REM is proud to continue to strengthen our partnership with ENTECH and expand our initiatives to provide sustainable energy and environmental solutions for waste management in North America".

REM and ENTECH will form a new US Company that will focus on the development of projects throughout the US.

The LA project is a joint venture project between REM, ENTECH, RAINBOW DISPOSAL and THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT.

The proposed facility is scheduled to be located at the Rainbow, Nichols Street MRF in Huntington Beach, CA.

New projects are currently in the planning stage of development and will be announced in the near future as they progress.
